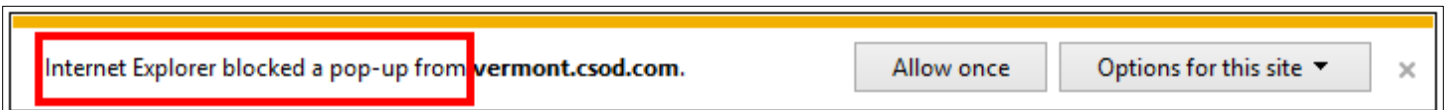


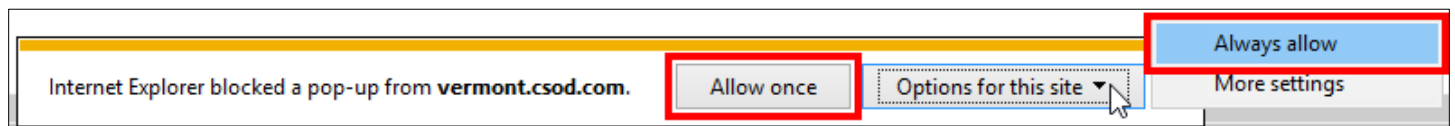
How-To Allow Pop-Ups in Internet Explorer Browser

Your Internet Explorer (IE) Browser is set to block pop-ups automatically, but sometimes that can interfere with opening content you actually want to see, like some of our training videos. Follow the steps below if you suspect IE is blocking pop-up content you want to see.

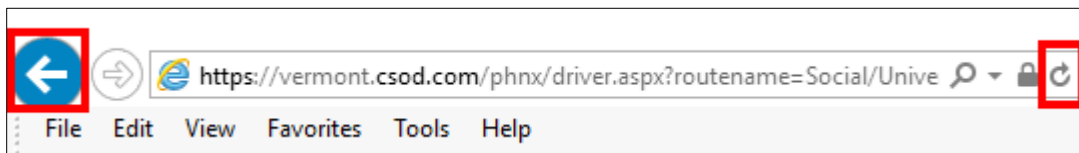
1. Look in the bottom middle part of the screen, right above your computer taskbar.
2. If a pop-up has been blocked, you will see a box with a bright yellow stripes that says “**Internet Explorer blocked a pop-up from...**”



3. You can choose one of two things, and you decide which applies to the site you're accessing:
 - a. Click the button for “**Allow once**” if you only want to allow this pop-up to open this time.
 - b. Click the button for “**Options for this site**” and choose “**Always allow**” to let pop-ups from this site to open from now on.



4. If nothing happens immediately, either **reload** the page by clicking the **circle-arrow button**, or **go back a page** by clicking the **left-arrow button** and then click the original link to re-launch the page.
